"On-The-Spot" 10-Minute Playwriting Competition

The Florida Theatre Conference is sponsoring an "On-The-Spot" Playwriting competition, which will offer an opportunity for students from different schools to collaborate on a 10-minute play, which must be written, cast, rehearsed, and performed in a very limited amount of time.

THE BASICS

Each assigned group of students - all from different schools - must write, stage, and perform an original ten-minute play. Each ensemble must include "certain elements" which will be given at the "On-The-Spot" Playwriting workshop on Friday evening. All of the original plays will be presented in a special "Works-In-Progress Showcase" performance on Saturday afternoon. Judges will critique plays and the winners will be announced at the FTC Awards ceremony on Saturday evening.

Writing teams will be announced at the "On-The-Spot" workshop Friday evening at 7:00 P.M. The teams are compiled prior to the conference so PLEASE DO NOT SIGN UP IF YOU ARE NOT SERIOUS ABOUT PARTICIPATING. Coordinators appreciate your effort to make this a wonderful experience for you and your playwriting teammates. If you sign up but do not show up on Friday evening to begin the process, then teams have to be adjusted and it is not easy to do that once on site. There are a limited number of spots for participation, so return your sign-up form early if you plan to participate this year. *Thank you!*
